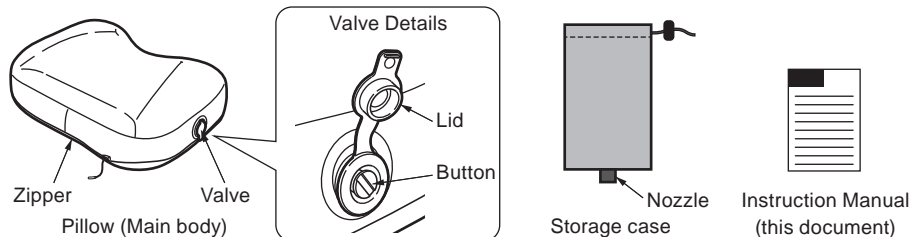


TM-097 Air Pillow

Thank you for purchasing a Snow Peak product. This product is an inflatable pillow designed for camping. For safety, read the following instruction manual before use. Please keep it safe for future reference. Finally, if you find anything that you do not understand in the description or any problems with the product, please stop use immediately and contact the retailer or Snow Peak Customer Service.

Safety Precautions: Before use, please read thoroughly to ensure safety and avoid accidents.

⚠ DANGER / Misuse could easily result in a serious accident or death.

- No fires: This product is not flame resistant. Do not use or leave the product near heat sources such as combustion lanterns, stoves, heaters, etc. Also, do not smoke in bed.
- Do not use this product for any purpose other than its intended use. Otherwise, an accident or injury may result.

⚠ WARNING / Misuse could result in serious injury or death.

Before using the product, check each part for abnormalities. If there are any abnormalities, take the product to the dealer or Snow Peak Customer Service for inspection or repair.

⚠ CAUTION / Misuse could result in injury to the user and/or damage to property.

- Over-inflating the pillow may cause irreparable damage. Do not leave the product fully inflated or use it in that condition.
- Do not stand or sit on the product, or throw it. Also, do not apply sudden force or pressure when releasing the air. Doing so may cause irreparable damage.
- Do not place the pillow directly on the ground when using it. Otherwise, it may be punctured by stones or plants on the ground.
- Do not use, store, or wash the pillow in hot water at temperatures above 40°C. Otherwise, heat may cause the adhesive to come apart.
- If the pillow is left inflated in places exposed to direct sunlight and high temperatures, such as inside a tent, shelter, or car during the day, the air inside may expand and damage the pillow.
- When not in use, always ensure that there is no pressure inside the pillow.
- Do not expose the pillow to direct sunlight for a long period of time. Ultraviolet rays may cause deterioration and reduce its durability.
- Do not use the pillow as a flotation device or substitute for a life jacket.
- When using the product, be careful not to damage it with sharp objects (such as knives or scissors) or metal fittings on clothing.
- Air may leak over time due to deterioration of the TPU material, even if there are no holes in the pillow. Please note that defects caused by normal wear and tear over time are not eligible for repair.
- Inflating the mattress by mouth may cause moisture to accumulate inside, which can lead to mold or bacterial growth, or deterioration. Please use the included pump (in the storage case) or a commercially available electric pump.
- Do not turn or press the valve button with your fingernails. Doing so may cause injury or damage. When adjusting the valve, turn it slowly using the pad of your finger.
- After prolonged use, moisture may accumulate inside the TPU film pillow. To prevent mold and bacterial growth, be sure to dry the pillow thoroughly after use.
- When inflating the pillow using an electric pump, set the pressure to 2.5 to 3.0 kPa. If the pressure is not displayed on the inflation tool, use the following guidelines: when you grip the edge with one hand, it should dent slightly. In addition, be careful not to inflate it so that it becomes completely firm. Always check the instruction manual of the pump you are using.
- Due to the nature of the fabric, pilling may occur.

Instructions for Use

[Instructions for Use]

Open the valve cover, make sure that the button is facing the "Check valve ON" position, and firmly insert the nozzle of the storage case into the valve. Inflate by filling the storage case with air and pushing it toward the nozzle.

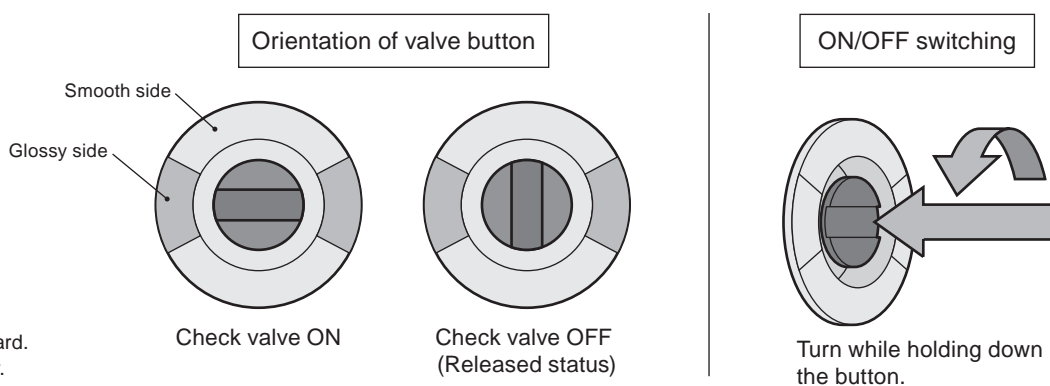
[Storage Method]

Press the center button on the valve and slowly release the air.

[Mode Change]

The pillow cover is reversible.

1. Release the air from inside the pillow and remove the pillow body through the zipper opening.
2. Turn the pillow inside out so that the inner fabric (cooling sensation) faces outward.
3. Put the cover on, making sure the pillow body aligns with the shape of the cover.



Maintenance

- Before using a product that has been in storage for a long time, check each part for abnormalities. If there are abnormalities, take the product to the retailer or contact Snow Peak Customer Service for inspection or repair.
- Storing the product in water or in a very humid environment, or exposing it to direct sunlight for an extended period of time, may cause the fabric to deteriorate rapidly and may lead to damage.
- Storing the product in water, in a very humid environment, or with dirt on it may cause mold to grow. Clean off any dirt and let it dry thoroughly before storing.
- When washing this product, please follow the instructions below and carefully read the caution label attached to the product.
 - Only the fabric cover can be washed. Do not wash the TPU film pillow body.
 - Use laundry detergent. Never use acidic or alkaline detergents.
 - Always use a laundry net when washing this product.
 - Do not wash with other laundry items, as the color may fade.
 - It may shrink after washing.

Warranty

Snow Peak has taken all possible measures to ensure every product is durable and functions correctly. If you find any product defects, please contact the retailer where you purchased the product or Snow Peak Customer Service. If there are apparent defects in the product's manufacturing, the defective product will be repaired or exchanged free of charge. In other cases, Snow Peak will repair the product for an appropriate fee. The decision to repair or replace the product will be at our discretion. Snow Peak will not repair the product for any damage that occurred due to the following: 1. Material deterioration caused by age / 2. Damage caused by modifications or rough handling / 3. Damage caused by inappropriate use not mentioned in the instruction manual / 4. Damage caused by unexpected accidents / 5. Any damage other than defects in the manufacturing process / 6. Damage caused by dust or rust / 7. Damage and defects caused by dismantling the product / 8. Damage and defects caused by dropping, jolting or other shocks / 9. Deterioration or failure of parts due to friction / 10. Damage caused by the use of the product in combination with another manufacturer's products
